#### **Discussion Questions:**

- 1. What can hinder believers from getting into the Word of God? List at least 3 things.
- 2. In addition to memorization, what else have you found helpful for getting into the Word?
  - I. **The Requirement:** Abide in His Word—*John 8:31-36* 
    - Christ promises spiritual freedom as we abide in His Word- 8:32 is
    - This spiritual freedom is from the dominating presence of indwelling sin- 33-36
- II. **The Source:** The Word is the God-breathed truth that shapes our lives —*2 Timothy* 3:16–17.
- III. **The Process:** Through the Word we train our senses—*Hebrews 5:12–14.*
- IV. **The Description:** Meditation upon the Word is like a cow chewing its cud—*Psalm* 1:1–3.

### Takeaways:

The benefits from abiding in the Word: Abiding in the Word of God provides us with the resources to be able to live as committed disciples of Jesus Christ:

- We develop an effective prayer life—John 15:7.
- We grow in a life that stays on course—*Psalm 119:9.*
- We discover an endless source of strength—*Psalm 119:28.*
- We become aware of potholes that can trip us up—*Psalm 119:105.*
